A low floor, wheelchair accessible vehicle is used. In addition, 'hail and ride', rather than fixed bus stops, operates along most of the routes to improve passenger access.

In terms of fares, an adult flat fare of £1.20 applies to all journeys and is valid for 75 minutes. The elderly, and people with a disability, who have a National Entitlement Card, travel free of charge.

49	Monday - Saturday (not Wednesday)	Hourly from 09.10 (08.35 Sat) to 15.26 (17.26 Sat)	Links the three main housing areas to the south of the High Street/Townhead, Castlemains and Kirkton, to the Town Centre and St Margaret's Health Centre/Hospital
49A	Wednesday only	Hourly from 09.30 to 15.27	Links Grand Eagles, Castleton Park, Glenorchil, Grampian Avenue, Muirton and Strathearn House to the Town Centre, Parkdale (New School Lane) and St Margaret's Health Centre/Hospital
